

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

JACQUES KANKU, #86,724
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta
also known as College of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect **June 10, 2022**. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a DCRA with the College, JACQUES KANKU, #86,724 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College include the following:

- While working as a staff RN in a psychiatric facility, the Registrant failed to contemporaneously and accurately document their patient care for at least three (3) patients.

The Registrant agreed to complete course work on documentation, pay a fine and complete a behavior improvement plan focused on improving critical thinking and ethical nursing care. The Registrant must also complete a period of supervision in their practice setting that includes audits of their documentation. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
