

# **DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT**

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

**BETWEEN:**

**TATSIANA TARASEVICH, #81,481**  
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

**College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta**  
**also known as College of Registered Nurses of Alberta**  
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect **September 9, 2022**. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a DCRA with the College, Tatsiana Tarasevich, #81,482 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College and includes the following:

- The Registrant failed to practice within their legislated scope of practice of the profession when, on one (1) occasion, they administered AbobotulinumtoxinA (Dysport) to Patient 1 without a patient-specific order from an authorized prescriber, and without ensuring that the patient was assessed by a physician or other authorized prescriber prior to administering AbobotulinumtoxinA (Dysport) to the patient. The Registrant also failed to adequately and/or contemporaneously document their care of Patient 1, and failed obtain informed consent from Patient 1, or adequately document informed consent, to the procedure of injecting neuromodulator AbobotulinumtoxinA (Dysport) and/or dermal filler.
- The Registrant failed to practice within their legislated scope of practice of the profession or demonstrate adequate judgment when they administered injectable neuromodulators and/or dermal fillers to one (1) or more patients without appropriate emergency support.

The Registrant must complete coursework on documentation and ethics in nursing and provide employer notifications for two (2) years. The Registrant will also be suspended for thirty (30) days. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
