

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

ALLISON GRANT, #84,010
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta
also known as College of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect **June 14, 2022**. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a DCRA with the College, ALLISON GRANT, #84,010 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arising from one (1) complaint to the College includes the following:

- On one (1) occasion while working in the Emergency Department at a hospital setting, the Registrant failed to demonstrate adequate knowledge, skill and/or judgment in the provision of nursing care to pediatric Patient 1 when they: failed to adequately monitor and/or respond to the patient’s condition; and failed to promote continuity of healthcare services when they failed to assist the patient and/or the patient’s mother after instructing the patient’s mother to administer the patient’s EpiPen®.

The Registrant agreed to complete course work focused on health assessment and pediatric emergencies. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
