

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

CHINWE MADUBUONU, #118,094
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

College of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect January 29, 2024. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through an Agreement with the College, CHINWE MADUBUONU, #118,094 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College include the following:

- On or around May 10, 2023, the Registrant failed to uphold medication administration and/or management standards, when they:
- Administered a discontinued medication to a patient;
- Gave a patient medication with another patient’s name on it; and
- Failed to use the Connect Care scanning safety system.

The Registrant agreed to complete course work on medication management and documentation, and will complete 120 hours of indirect supervision. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
