

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

AMANDA BAYRAK, #83,344
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

College of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect July 3, 2025. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through an Agreement with the College, AMANDA BAYRAK, #83,344 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from two (2) complaints to the College include the following:

- On multiple occasions on or between November 7, 2024, and January 25, 2025, the Registrant demonstrated a lack of knowledge, skill and/or judgment in the provision of professional nursing services when they did one (1) or more of the following:
 - Failed to adequately assess and monitor a patient;
 - Failed to notice a patient was deceased in a timely manner;
 - Failed to document adequately on 4 separate occasions;
 - Failed to give a patient the correct dose of codeine syrup.

The Registrant agreed to complete course work on documentation and assessment and employer references covering a total of 400 nursing practice hours. The Registrant agreed to a suspension for 20 days, with 10 days commencing immediately and the remaining 10 days held in abeyance for two years. The Registrant further agreed to provide a medical letter from a physician. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
